## (translated from robots) The Jewish conspiracy, is it no longer relevant?

We don't hear this story about a "global Jewish conspiracy" much anymore; it seems to be out of date! It's more likely that Christians are in control of the world economy and politics. As a reminder, the biggest billionaires are Christians or from Christian families... Okay, it's true, it was already the case for several centuries (millennia?), it's not a new discovery... And you had to be pretty limited to believe in a Jewish conspiracy and not a Christian one (or was/is it a subterfuge of the Christian or conservative powers in order to divert attention from their real power?). Scapegoats are very convenient for avoiding addressing the real problem of class societies and the tensions that this creates within societies under its yoke.

How is it then that anti-Semites who are religious/national opponents of Jews, that is to say, Christians or Islamists, and rather far-right (and far-center or far-left?) identitarians, are not shouting about a "global Christian conspiracy" at the moment? Perhaps it is the fact that, since reality says otherwise, and the internet allows us to find real information, conspiracies can no longer have a place in public discourse. For them, this would be pointing the finger at their own paranoid and conspiracy-theorist friends currently in financial power. I forgot... Elites of French far-right parties (founded by former SS and other local fascists, having had problems with details of history) even went to Israel to support the action of the Israeli far-right... the far-right of one country and another come together, support each other, it is known historically... There is even a certain lawyer who fought legally against former Nazi criminals of the 2nd World War who now supports the previously so -hated French far-right party.

Hamas (an offshoot of the "Muslim Brotherhood"), an Islamist religious far-right, did not arrive where it is today by chance. The "Muslim Brotherhood" (Islamist political movement) were paid and accompanied by the Israeli state for about twenty years until the appearance of Hamas. The goal is to divide the Palestinians in partisan struggles (between PA and Hamas) over the use of power.

Israeli powers subsequently supported various agreements with Hamas, they also supported Qatar's aid funding of the Gaza Strip, they supported Hamas in Gaza rather than the Palestinian Authority in the West Bank. The political and religious repression within Gaza by Hamas has not led to a protest from the Israeli powers. They are their far-right pawns.

On the other hand, we still and often hear anti-Semitic propagandists stating a "Jewish conspiracy", the far-right media (from all geographical areas, of all religions) are specialists in this type of conspiratorial discourse...

So, we cannot see a specific global Jewish conspiracy, on the other hand we can see a global conspiracy of capitalism and statists against their subordinates. Whether they are from one political side or another, even if currently it is rather the extreme right... and whether they are Christians, Jews, Muslims, Hindus, Buddhists or others, it is obvious that it does not change much in this powerlessness to which they want to subject us all. And what is certain is that they are not part of the solution but of the problem.

So, while we're at it with conspiracy, let's be honest! Let's plot against authoritarianism and states, whose representatives are theisms, capitalisms, and nationalisms . Long live the workers' conspiracy against this unbearable old world! Let's prepare a nasty surprise for them and not be bad !

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
